Parade Theme: “Diamond Anniversary – 60 Years of the 4th of July in Atwater”

Date and Time of Parade: Tuesday, July 4th, 2023 at 9:00am

Check in: Ralston Park Monday, July 3rd from 3:00pm - 6:00pm

Parade Route: Line-up begins at Foster Freeze and ends at the corner of Juniper and Winton Way based on your number. **Parade begins at the corner of Elm and Winton Way**, turns left onto Broadway, turns left onto 3rd street and ends at the corner of Juniper and 3rd street. The Reviewing Stand will be on 3rd street somewhere between Elm and Grove Street.

Trophies will be awarded at **11:30 am at the APC Hall Stage**. One winner per category will be awarded PLUS one overall Grand Winner.

I hereby release the Atwater 4th of July committee Inc., the Atwater Chamber of Commerce, the City of Atwater and the County of Merced from all liability for any act of negligence or want of ordinary care on the part of the above named organization or any of its agents.

In consideration of acceptance of any application in regards to the Atwater 4th of July, I wave, release, and discharge the Atwater 4th of July committee Inc., the City of Atwater, the County of Merced and their directors, officers, agents, and members, their representatives, heirs, executors, and assigns from any and all claims of liability for injury or damage to myself, or my property, arising out of my participation. This agreement is binding upon the executor, heirs, and assigns.

I expressly waive any rights I may have under the California Civil Code 1542, which states, "A general release does not extend to claims which the creditor does not know or suspect to exist in his favor a the time of executing the release, which if known by him might have materially affected his settlement with the debtor."

I agree that I will indemnify and hold harmless the Atwater 4th of July Committee Inc., the City of Atwater, the county of Merced, the Atwater Chamber of Commerce, and their officers, directors members and agents against all claims, demands, and causes of action, including court cost and actual attorney fees, arising from any proceeding or lawsuits brought by or prosecuted for my benefit, in which this release is upheld.

2023* Parade Rules *2023

1. ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST ADHERE TO MERCED COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT GUIDELINES.
2. All participants must disband at the END of the Parade in the disband area (PASTJUNIPER). There will be no riding on vehicles illegally back to the starting point.
3. Parade numbers will be obtained at the registration desk at Ralston Park on Monday July the 3rd from 3:00pm to 6:00pm (late check in at 8:00am - 8:15 am on Tuesday July the 4th at Atwater High School in front of the office area)
4. Participants will maintain numerical order.
5. Control of vehicles or animals must be maintained at all times.
6. All participants must clean up after themselves or any animal they are in charge of.
7. Living things on floats must be secure.
8. **There is to be no “entourages” following along with the participants.**
Chaperones should be a part of the parade and not interfere with other spectators. Please remind family and friends that they may not walk along the parade route with parade participants.
9. **There will be no large gatherings at the judging booth.** All spectators should remain in one spot for the duration of the parade. Please remind friends and family that they may not crowd around the judging booth.
10. Entries under age 6 must be accompanied by an adult over 21.
11. Music from floats/cars will maintain a volume so as to not interfere with others.
12. Vehicles must be decorated except for windshield and radiators.
13. No items may be thrown by parade participants. **Items MAY be handed out by walkers.**
14. No water may be sprayed from any entry except the Fire Department.
15. There is a return check charge of \$25.00.
16. Entries received after June 28th will be placed at the end of the parade.
17. Entries are randomly placed in the line-up to provide a variety throughout the parade. Early entries do not guarantee placement at the front of the parade. Last minute entries will be placed at the end of the parade.

Please adhere to all rules to make this a comfortable, family friendly, and safe event.
